

Aspire to be a Good Modernite

This means :

1. To abide by the school rules and thus help in fostering the spirit of harmony resulting from self-imposed discipline.
2. To be punctual in all activities whether in school or at home.
3. To remember always your duty to yourself, your school, your community, your country and to your fellow beings.
4. To observe personal cleanliness and to keep the school premises neat and clean.
5. To always use cloth bags, paper bags or jute bags as they are environment friendly and to strictly avoid the use of polythene bags.
6. To avoid wasting energy by shouting as it can cause noise pollution.
7. To switch off the electric switches and close the taps when not in use.
8. To be the custodian of school property and to help in the maintenance of lawns, playgrounds and gardens.
9. To lend a helping hand at home to your parents, brothers and sisters and in school to teachers and fellow students, and to all who need your help.
10. To treat everyone with courtesy. Good manners should be the hallmark of a Modernite. Wherever you are be courteous and polite.
11. To look upon people from all parts of the country and the world as your brothers/sisters irrespective of their caste, creed or religion.
12. To be moderate in spending pocket money. Any undue display of wealth is unbecoming of a Modernite.
13. To eschew lamenting and grumbling over the evils of the world and always try to think and work constructively to make it a better place to live in.
14. To act as an Ambassador of the school in all situations and create goodwill for your esteemed institution everywhere.
15. To manifest Aryan virtues of politeness, kindness, nobility, integrity, honesty, truthfulness in behaviour, both at school and home.
16. To endeavour to attain physical, mental, moral and spiritual growth to the best of your capacity.
17. To remember your school Motto, **Truth Triumphs.**

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RULES FOR STUDENTS

1. Students should be habitually clean and neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn on all school days and on all occasions of functions organised by the school. The general appearance of the student should conform to such regulations as the school prescribes.
2. Non-Sikh boys should have their hair trimmed at regular intervals. Sikh boys should wear Navy Blue turbans / Mini turbans.
PENALTY : The defaulter will be charged a fine of ₹ 20/- for violation of Rule 1 and 2.
3. It is strictly forbidden to throw anything out of place and / or at anyone.
4. No Bullying shouting or whistling is allowed within the school premises.
PENALTY: The students will be subjected to disciplinary action depending upon the gravity of the situation.
5. Students have to be punctual and regular to school and at the stroke of the bell at 7:30 am they should join the Assembly in a disciplined manner.
6. Observe order and decorum befitting the occasion.
7. Students must not bring any sharp instrument to school.
PENALTY : Violator of this rule will be punishable to the extent of expulsion or suspension as the school authorities finalize after considering the gravity of the situation.
8. Students must not bring any undesirable item to school.
9. It is necessary that students obey the monitor appointed by the class teacher and remain perfect discipline at all times of the day.
10. Students must not lend / borrow money or other articles from each other.
11. Students are expected to be polite, courteous, respectful and well disciplined inside and outside the school.
12. Each classroom of the school is equipped with Smart Class equipment. Students must take utmost care of it and of the other school property. No student should scratch or spoil any school furniture, or write or draw lines on the walls or in any other manner damage things belonging to others. Damage done even by accident, by any one, should be reported at once to the Class Teacher or to the Principal. Any damage done will have to be made good either individually or collectively as the case may be.

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PENALTY : The student(s) will be subjected to monetary fine / disciplinary action depending upon the gravity of the situation.

13. If any student comes to school under the care of the servant in his/her own transport, he/she should never leave the school before the servant or the transport arrives. In case of delay, he/she should report to the school office.

14. Students who travel by bus should wait at the bus stand in an orderly fashion and should not board or alight from a moving bus or project any part of their body out of the bus nor should they stand on the footboard of the bus.

PENALTY : Student/s found violating this rule will be debarred from availing the bus facility.

15. Use of unfair means during the examination is strictly prohibited.

PENALTY : The student indulging in unfair means will be awarded zero marks in the concerned subject besides disciplinary action.

16. Disobedience, use of abusive language, irregularity with the home tasks and class work, creating indiscipline in the class, disturbing other students, bunking the class or indulging in any such act of indiscipline that is against the school rules and regulations is strictly prohibited.

PENALTY : External Memo will be issued to the defaulter. Three External Memos in one academic year can lead to expulsion or rustication of the student from the school.

17. Use of mobile phones by students is strictly prohibited within the school premises.

PENALTY : The cell phone will be destroyed in the presence of the students in the school assembly.

18. Students are not authorized to drive personal two wheelers or cars to school without a licence.

PENALTY : If any student is found doing so, it would lead to direct suspension of the student from the class and / or the school authorities can take suitable action depending upon the gravity of the situation.

19. Celebrations of any kind for example birthdays etc. are not allowed in the school.

PENALTY : The parents of the offenders would be called to sign an undertaking and further action would be taken according to the gravity of the situation.

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20. Wearing of gold ornaments and jewellery is not permitted in the school. Ear piercing is not allowed for the boys.
21. No child is allowed to apply mehandi on any occasion.
PENALTY : Student(s) will be sent back home.
22. The medium of instruction is English. It is compulsory for all students to converse in English as the CBSE syllabus stresses on students competence to speak confidently and fluently in English.
23. It is mandatory for every student to wear School Identity Card around his neck during school hours.
PENALTY : The ones not doing so will be subjected to a fine of ₹ 20.
24. Special badges given by the school must be worn daily.
25. Every student has to remain quiet during five minutes' silence period that is observed everyday. The aim is to increase the retention and concentration power amongst students.
26. It is mandatory for each student to participate in school functions.
27. It is mandatory for each student to be present in the school on Compulsory Attendance days.
PENALTY : Violators of Rules 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 20, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27 will be subjected to disciplinary action.
28. No student shall indulge in any of the following practices, namely:
- Writing on the shirts or uniform.
 - Spitting in or near the school building.
 - Rowdyism.
 - Use of violence in any form.
 - Bursting crackers or throwing colour on one another / or painting faces within the school premises.
- PENALTY :** Students who do not abide by this rule and its sub rules, could be punished to the extent of expulsion or suspension as the school authorities finalize after considering the gravity of the act.
29. Appearing in the Annual Examination / Summative Assessments is compulsory.
PENALTY : The result of the students who do not follow this rule will be withheld based on the code of conduct issued by the CBSE.
