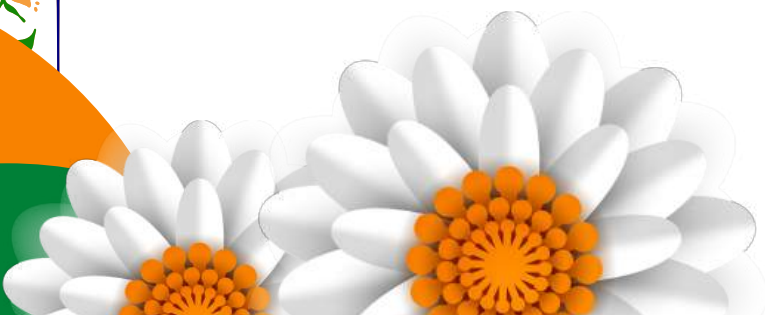


Embracing Our Responsibilities and Building a Better Future
